AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 566 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 839 AND PROVIDING FOR THE HOLDING OF REGULAR COUNCIL MEETINGS IN CASES WHERE THE ESTABLISHED DATE SET THEREFORE CONFLICTS WITH A LEGAL HOLIDAY.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance 566 as heretofore amended by Ordinance No. 839 be and the same hereby is amended to read as follows and Ordinance No. 839 is thereby repealed:

"Section 2. That the two regular meetings of the City Council of the City of Kirkland to be held each month as hereinbefore provided shall be held on the first and third Monday of each calendar month provided that at such time as a regular meeting date may conflict with a legal holiday such regular meeting shall be held on the Tuesday immediately following such legal holiday."

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 566 is in all other respects confirmed and unchanged.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall be in force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
