

ORDINANCE NO. 1054

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON RELATING TO LAND USE PLANNING AND ZONING REQUIRING SEPARATE PETITIONS FOR REZONE OR RECLASSIFICATION OF NON-CONTIGUOUS PARCELS OF LAND AND AMENDING SUB-SECTION 8.2.10 OF KIRKLAND ORDINANCE NO. 709.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sub-section 8.2.10 of the Kirkland Zoning Code being Ordinance No. 709 and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Sub-section 8.2.10. The owner of any land desiring a change in use, zone boundaries, or a reclassification of property, shall present to the Planning Commission a petition signed and acknowledged by him on the forms provided by the City stating his proposal. Drawings including maps delineating the proposal, shall accompany the petition. Non-contiguous parcels of land shall require separate petitions."

Section 2. Ordinance 709 as heretofore amended and supplemented and is in all other respects ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication is required by law.
