## ordinance no. 1059

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE No. R-10/66-17, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, FROM R-8.5 to R-3.

WHEREAS, Petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described under Planning Commission File No. R-10/66-17 and subsequently pursuant to proper notice, public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on October 20, 1966, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and,

Lots 1, 2, 11, 17, 18, 19, 20, E 1/2 of Lot 16, Block 188, Town of Kirkland, according to plat thereof, records of King County.

Location: Between 4th and 5th Streets and 6th and 7th Avenues.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take

effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
