

ORDINANCE NO. 1069

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-1/67-1 AND SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R-12.5 to R-3.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described property situate in the City of Kirkland be, and the same hereby is rezoned from R-12.5, Single Family Residence, to R-3 Multiple Family Residence:

Lots 11 through 14, inclusive, Block 92,
Blewitt's First Addition to Kirkland

Said property generally located between 18th and 19th Avenues on Market Street.



Petition No. R-1/67-1, filed with the Kirkland Planning Commission, requesting rezone of the above-described property, was considered and recommended to the Council by the Kirkland Planning Commission following public hearing thereon before said body on February 2, 1967. Further public hearing was held before the Kirkland City Council on the 20th day of February, 1967.


This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days after its passage, approval and legal publication as required by law.
