

ORDINANCE NO.

1072

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO MASTER PINBALL LICENSES AND POOL TABLE LICENSES, CHANGING THE EFFECTIVE DATE FOR SUCH LICENSES AND THE PAYMENT OF SUCH LICENSE FEES, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 958 OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1:

Section 1-B of Ordinance No. 958 of the City of Kirkland be, and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 1 (b) Pool Tables - \$10.00 per year for each table, payable on the second day of January for each calendar year.

Section 2. Section 2 of Ordinance No. 958 be, and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 2. No pinball amusement devices shall be operated in the City of Kirkland unless the owner thereof shall first have secured from the City of Kirkland a master license for the operation of the same. Upon the payment to the Clerk of the City of Kirkland of an annual license fee of \$1,000.00 for the calendar year commencing on January 1st and terminating on December 31st, anyone holding a valid master license from the City of Kirkland may operate as many pinball amusement devices thereunder within the City of Kirkland as he desires."

Section 3. It is the intent of this amendatory ordinance to change only the effective date of the license period and the time when license payments are due, and such change shall not operate to result in the payment by the licensee of a greater or lesser license fee than he would otherwise pay. Where necessary license fees shall be prorated to accomplish the purpose and intention of this ordinance.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 958 entitled "An Ordinance of the City of Kirkland, Washington, regulating the operation of

pinball amusement devices and pool tables, and providing license fees therefore and penalties for the operation of the same in violation of this ordinance, and repealing Ordinance Nos. 532, 609, 610 and 894 of the City of Kirkland." be in all other respects ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
