ordinance no. 1084

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE No. R-11/66-23B, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, FROM R-8.5 TO R-3L.

WHEREAS, petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described under Planning Commission File No. R-11/66-23B, and subsequently, pursuant to proper notice, a public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on April 6, 1967, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice, public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the day of May, 1967,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from R-8.5 to R-3L classification:

Lots 9 and 10, Block 4, Commercial Addition to Kirkland. Location: South end of vacated portion of 1st St. So. in 700 block.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, and publication as required.by law.
