

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE No. R-67-21 SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R-6 to R-S CLASSIFICATION.

WHEREAS, Petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically, described in the Planning Commission File No. R-4/67-21, and subsequently pursuant to proper notice a public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on May 4, 1967, and after hearing recommendation was made to the City Council recommending such reclassification, and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 5<sup>th</sup> day of JUNE, 1967,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is, rezoned from R-6 Single-family residence classification to R-S Semi-public classification:

The South 1/2 of the south 1/2 of Lots 32A and 32, and the South 1/2 of Lot 31, Block 53, Burke & Farrar's Kirkland Addition, Division No. 15.  
Location: 680 Kirkland, Way.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
