ORDINANCE NO.100

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, AMENDING SECTION 12 OF ORDINANCE NO. 569 (HERETOFORE AMENDED BY OR-DINANCE NO. 825) ESTABLISHING FEES TO BE PAID TO THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FOR WATER SERVICE CONNECTIONS AND SETTING FORTH RE-QUIREMENTS THERETO.

The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 12 of Ordinance No. 569 as heretofore amended by Ordinance No. 825 be, and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 12 - Service connection fees:

All water service connections shall be made by the Kirkland Water-Sewer Department and the fees to be paid therefore shall be as follows:

A. Meter installation charge:

5/8" x 3/4" meter installation up to 60' in length	\$110.00
3/4" x 3/4" meter installation up to 60' in length	125.00
l" meter installation up to 60' in length	150.00

Meters in excess of 1" Cost plus overhead

That portion of any service installation in excess of 60' in length

Cost plus overhead

For the purposes of this sub-section, cost plus overhead shall include the following:

Materials at cost plus 10% to cover cost of taxes, handling, etc.; equipment use at current established hourly rental rate; and labor at current hourly rate, plus 25%.

B. Connection charge per meter: Provided that any meter which is installed as an exempt meter for purposes relating solely to sewer rate charges shall be exempt from the connection charge.

Each single-family residence, multiple housing building or development and business building using water from the City of Kirkland's Water System shall have a separate, direct connection with the water main and a separate shut-off and a separate water service connection fee, including both the meter installation charge and the connection charge, shall be made for each such connection.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 569 is in all other respects confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
