AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-7/67-44, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, FROM R-12.5 (SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENCE) TO R-2 (RESIDENTIAL DUPLEX CLASSIFICATION).
