AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-4/67-26, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, FROM S-A, SUBURBAN AGRICULTURAL, TO C-M, CONTROLLED MANUFACTURING.

MEREAS. Petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described under Planning Commission File No. R-4/67-26, and subsequently pursuant to proper notice, public hearings were held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on August 17, 1967, and again on September 7, 1967, and after hearings recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 2nd day of October, 1967,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from S-A, Suburban Agricultural, to C-M, Controlled Manufacturing classification:

> N 1/2 of the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Sec. 33, Township 26 North, Range 5 East, W.M. in King County, Washington; EXCEPT N.P. R/W, and EXCEPT the South 330 ft, thereof,

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
