

ORDINANCE NO. 1114

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-8/67-50, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, FROM R-8.5 SINGLE-FAMILY RESIDENCE TO R-S SEMI-PUBLIC.

WHEREAS, Petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described under Planning Commission File No. R-8/67-50, and subsequently pursuant to proper notice, public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on September 21, 1967, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 16th day of October, 1967,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described property be and the same hereby is rezoned from R-8.5 single-family residence to R-S semi-public classification:

Block 2,  
W. B. Fehr's Kirkland Home Tracts according to plat thereof,  
records of King County, except Lots 14 and 18 of said Block  
2.

Location: All of Block 2 of W.B. Fehr's Kirkland Home Tracts, except Lots 14 and 18. (The area is bounded by 5th Avenue South on the North, 9th Avenue South on the South, 7th Street South on the east and 6th Street South on the west.)


Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
