

ORDINANCE NO. 1130

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-12/67-66, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R-12.5 (Single-family residence) to R-3 (Multi-family residence).

WHEREAS, petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described in the Planning Commission File No. R-12/67-66, and subsequently pursuant to proper notice a public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on December 28, 1967, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 15th day of JANUARY, 1968,

NOW, THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is rezoned from R-12.5 (single-family residence) to R-3 (multi-family residence) classification:

Lots 1 and 2, Block 190, Kirkland Addition

Location: 239 - 7th Avenue, Kirkland, Washington

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
