

ORDINANCE NO. 1131

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF THE BALANCE ON HAND IN THE LIBRARY GENERAL FUND IN THE APPROXIMATE AMOUNT OF \$556.23 TO THE CURRENT EXPENSE FUND FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, the Kirkland Library has heretofore become affiliated with, and now is operated by the King County Library, and

WHEREAS, the payments required to be made by the City of Kirkland for said library services have been assumed by and budgeted to be paid from the current expense fund, and,

WHEREAS, the need for a separate library fund is therefore no longer required,

NOW THEREFORE, It is hereby ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Director of Administration and Finance is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the balance of moneys remaining in the Library General Fund as of the date of adoption of this ordinance to the current expense fund for the City of Kirkland. Said balance being in the approximate amount of \$556.23.

Section 2. This ordinance shall in no way be construed to affect the library cumulative reserve fund and the funds on deposit therein.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
