

ORDINANCE NO. 1132

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-1/68-2, SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R-3 (MULTI-HOUSING) AND R-8.5 (SINGLE-FAMILY) TO R-S (SEMI-PUBLIC).

WHEREAS, petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described in the Planning Commission File No. R-1/68-2, and subsequently pursuant to proper notice a public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on January 25, 1968, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 19th day of February, 1968.

NOW THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is rezoned from R-3 (Multi-Housing) and R-8.5 (Single-Family) to R-S (Semi-Public) classification:

Lots 1 - 6, Block 1, Seattle Addition to Kirkland, according to Plat recorded, Volume 7 of Plats, page 16, records of King County, Washington.

Approximate Location: Southwest corner of intersection of State Street & 5th Avenue South.
(Portion of 515 State Street).

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
