

ORDINANCE NO. 1135

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A WATER-SEWER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS CUMULATIVE RESERVE FUND , PROVIDING FOR TRANSFER OF MONEYS THERETO, LIMITING EXPENDITURES THEREFROM, AND SUPPLEMENTING ORDINANCE No. 583.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby established pursuant to RCW 35.21.070, et seq., for the City of Kirkland Water-Sewer Department a cumulative reserve fund to be known as the Water-Sewer Cumulative Reserve Fund. Said fund is established for the purposes of comprehensive program planning, preliminary study and planning, acquisition, construction, maintenance, replacement, alteration and repair of water-sewer capital improvements, facilities and property, both real and personal.

Section 2. The moneys in said fund herein established may be allowed to accumulate from year to year until the Kirkland City Council shall determine to expend the moneys in said fund for the purpose or purposes hereinabove specified, provided that any moneys in said fund shall never be expended for any other purposes than those herein specified without an approving vote by a majority of the electors of the City of Kirkland at a general or special election voting on a proposal submitted to the electors to allow other specified uses to be made of said fund.

Section 3. An item for said cumulative reserve fund may be included in the City of Kirkland annual budget or estimate of amounts required to meet public expense for the ensuing year, and said item may be repeated from year to year until in the judgment of the City Council the amount required for the purposes herein specified shall have been raised or accumulated. Any moneys in said fund at the end of the fiscal year shall not lapse, nor shall the same be a surplus available or which may be used for any other purpose or purposes than those specified except as in this ordinance provided.

Section 4. The City Council may upon unanimous vote from time to time direct the City Treasurer to transfer to the fund herein created such moneys then held in the current expense fund as said Council may then deem surplus to the annual current needs of the City of Kirkland Water-Sewer Department Cumulative Reserve Fund.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required.
