

ORDINANCE NO. 1152

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY SITUATE WITHIN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-4/68-14 FROM R-12.5 TO R-7.2.

WHEREAS, petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described in the Planning Commission File No. R-4/68-14, and subsequently pursuant to proper notice a public hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission on May 23, 1968, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification, and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 17th day of June, 1968,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described property be, and the same hereby is rezoned from R-12.5 to R-7.2 classification:

Lots 7, 8, 9, Block 120, Burke and Farrar's Division No. 27, according to plat thereof, records of King County.

Approximate Location: 1815 1st Street (Vicinity)

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
