ORDINANCE NO. 1158

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE PUBLIC SAFETY AND WELFARE, AND AMENDING SUB-SECTION 8 OF SECTION 805 OF CHAPTER VIII OF ORDINANCE 895 AS HERETOFORE AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 957.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND as follows:

Section 1. Sub-section 8 of Section 805 of Chapter VIII of Ordinance No. 895 as heretofore amended by Ordinance No. 957 be, and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 805, sub-section 8. The following shall be deemed disorderly persons and guilty of a violation of this sub-section:

Any person who shall make, carry, possess, or use any type of 'molotov cocktail', gasoline or petroleum base fire bomb or other incendiary missile. For the purposes of this sub-section, 'molotov cocktail' shall mean a gasoline-filled bottle or container with a fuse-type wick inserted in the neck (commonly used in World War II).

Section 2. Ordinance No. 895 of the City of Kirkland, the Kirkland Penal Ordinance as heretofore amended is in all other respects ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
