

ORDINANCE NO. 2005

AN ORDINANCE OF THE NEWLY CONSOLIDATED CITY OF KIRKLAND, RELATING TO THE ORDERLY TRANSFER UPON CONSOLIDATION AND ADOPTING AN INTERIM BUDGET FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE CALENDAR YEAR OF 1968.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The interim budget of the City of Kirkland for the remainder of the calendar year, 1968, be, and the same is adopted, and the appropriation totals shall be allowed for each of the following classes as follows:

1. Salary and wages	<u>\$ 249,982.00</u>
2. Maintenance and operation	<u>392,276.00</u>
3. Capital outlay	<u>3,379,241.00</u>
4. Interest and debt reduction	<u>329,491.00</u>
5. Other	<u>43,800.00</u>
Total estimated revenue	<u>\$ 4,394,790.00</u>

Section 2. The budget herein adopted is a consolidation of the budgets adopted by the former cities of Houghton and Kirkland for the calendar year 1968, and the tax levies fixed by said cities at the time of the adoption of their respective budgets in October, 1967, shall remain, and said levies shall in no way be affected by this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect immediately upon its passage by the Council.
