AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-1/1/69/2. SITUATE IN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND FROM R-3 MULTI-FAMILY AND R-8.5 SINGLE FAMILY to RS SEMI-PUBLIC.
