

ORDINANCE NO. 2041

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE FIREMAN'S RELIEF AND PENSION SYSTEM AND TO ITS ADMINISTRATION AND OPERATION AND ESTABLISHING THE MEMBERSHIP OF THE FIREMAN'S PENSION BOARD FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:


Section 1. A fireman's relief and pension system is hereby declared to have been established and created for the City of Kirkland full time, full paid fire Department as of March 1, 1969 and the Fireman's Pension Board thereby created shall consist of the following five members, ex officio the Mayor who shall be Chairman of the Board, the City Manager, the Director of Administration and Finance and in addition two members to be elected by secret ballot of the Fireman at least one of which must be a regularly employed fireman.

Section 2. Except as provided in Section 1, the Fireman's Relief and Pension system shall be administered and operated under the provisions of and in compliance with the applicable laws of the State of Washington.


Section 3. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect 5 days from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
