

ORDINANCE NO. 2064

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ADOPTING STANDARD SPECIFICATIONS FOR MUNICIPAL PUBLIC WORKS CONSTRUCTION AND AMENDING SECTION ONE OF ORDINANCE NO. 911.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 911, adopted July 15, 1963, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. (a) Except as hereinafter provided, all public works construction, including but not limited to streets, sewers and water distribution system in the City of Kirkland shall conform to the Standard Specifications for Municipal Public Works Construction of the Washington State Chapter of the American Public Works Association published in 1969, including any future amendments, modifications or changes thereof adopted and issued by said Association.

(b) Specifications which modify, change or substitute for the standard specifications hereinabove adopted may be established for a particular Public Works project when the use of such nonstandard specifications is, in the opinion of the Director of Public Services, beneficial to the public interest. All nonstandard specifications shall be clearly identified as such and shall be set forth in full detail and as a part of the special conditions prepared for such project. In all such cases, the special conditions shall be specially approved by the City Council prior to the authorization to call for bids.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 911 is in all other respects hereby ratified and confirmed, together with the supplemental detail specifications adopted by Ordinance No. 1083 which shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect 5 days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
