

ORDINANCE NO. 2073

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, VACATING A PORTION OF N. E. 67th STREET (COLLINSWOOD DRIVE)

WHEREAS, by resolution heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, date was set for the public hearing upon the proposed vacation of that certain portion of N. E. 67th Street as more fully hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of said hearing was had in accordance with law, and

WHEREAS, following said public hearing, held October 6, 1969, a vote of the Council was taken favoring said vacation, and

WHEREAS, it appears desirable and to the best interest of the City, its residents and property owners abutting thereon that said portion of N. E. 67th Street,

WHEREAS, the abutting property owners have donated land for a replacement cul de sac.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described portion of said street situate in Kirkland, King County, Washington and described as follows:

That portion of N. E. 67th (originally platted as Collinswood Drive in Collinswood Division No. 2 as recorded in Volume 20 of Plats, Page 50 in King County, Washington) lying southerly of the south westerly margin of Washington State Highway SR 405 and lying northerly of the following described line:

Beginning at the Northeasterly corner of Lot 2, of Block 1 of the Collinswood Division No. 2, as recorded in Volume 20 of Plats, Page 50, King County, Washington; thence south $0^{\circ}45'19''$ West 115.79 feet more or less to the southeasterly corner being the true point of beginning; thence $89^{\circ}14'41''$ east 10.87 feet; thence northeasterly


along a curve to the right a distance of 22.14 feet more or less to a point on the easterly margin of said 67th Street (Collinswood Drive) said curve having a radius of 45 feet and having its center at a point south 42°14'58" east 45 feet from the point of beginning of a curve. Said portion of street abutting on and lying easterly of Lots 1 and 2, Block 1, Collinswood Division No. 2.

be and the same hereby is vacated, except that the City shall retain and reserve an easement, together with the right to exercise and grant easements along, over and across said vacated street for the installations, construction, repair and maintenance of public utilities and services.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.


