

ORDINANCE NO. 2079

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ESTABLISHING SAID CITY AS A NONCHARTER CODE CITY UNDER RCW TITLE 35A.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Kirkland duly passed Resolution No. 2038 at regular meeting on August 4, 1969, declaring its intention to change the classification of said city from that of a city of the third class to that of a noncharter code city, and

WHEREAS, said resolution was duly published in the manner required by law and more than 90 days having elapsed since the date of first publication thereof, and

WHEREAS, no referendum petition has been filed with the respect to such resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Notwithstanding anything contained in the existing ordinances of the City of Kirkland to the contrary, the City of Kirkland, Washington, hereby adopts the classification of a noncharter code city operating under the Council Manager Plan of government as set forth in Chapter 35A.13 of the Revised Code of Washington, endowed with all the applicable rights, powers, privileges, duties, and obligations of noncharter code cities as set forth in Title 35A of said Revised Code of Washington as the same now exists, including, but not by way of limitation, those set forth in Chapter 35A.11 of said Title, and further including any and all supplements, amendments or other modifications of said title hereafter at any time enacted.

Section 2. The Director of Administration and Finance as ex officio city clerk is hereby directed to file with the Secretary of State for the State of Washington, a certified copy of this ordinance.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect 5 days from and after the date of its passage and publication.
