## ORDINANCE NO. 2082

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ESTABLISHING SALARIES FOR CITY OFFICES AND OFFICIALS TO BECOME EFFECTIVE AT SUCH TIME AS THE CITY MAY BE ESTABLISHED AS A NONCHARTER CODE CITY OPERATING UNDER THE COUNCIL-MANAGER PLAN OF GOVERNMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. At such time as the City of Kirkland may hereafter be established as a noncharter code city operating under the City Manager plan of government as set forth in RCW 35A.13, the salaries for the city officials shall, commencing as of the effective date of such noncharter code city establishment, be as follows:

Councilman

\$ 40.00 per month

The councilman serving as mayor shall receive an additional \$60.00 per month.

For all other city offices and positions as may from time to time be established (including but not by way of limitation, the City Manager and the Director of Administration and Finance - ex officio Clerk Treasurer) the salaries shall be as set forth in the annual budget as adopted for each year.

Section 2. The individuals holding the offices for which salaries are hereinabove established shall be entitled to receive such salaries commencing with the effective date of the establishment of Kirkland as a noncharter code city under the Council Manager Plan of government, unless prohibited from doing so by any provision of the Washington State Constitution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect from and after 5 days from the date of its passage and publication.
