ORDINANCE NO. 2086

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY; INTOXICATION RESULTING FROM ALCOHOL OR DRUGS AND AMENDING SECTION 512 OF ORDINANCE 895 OF THE KIRKLAND PENAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 512 of Ordinance No. 895 commonly known as the Kirkland Penal Code, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 512--Being under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drug in a public place--

"Every person who is found in any public place under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug or the combined influence of intoxicating liquor and any drug in such a condition that he is unable to care for his own safety or the safety of others, or who, by reason of his being under the influence of intoxicating liquor or any drug interferes with or obstructs or prevents the free use of any street, sidewalk or other public way shall be guilty of a misdemeanor."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect 5 days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
