

ORDINANCE NO. 2089

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO METHODS OF IDENTIFICATION OF CERTAIN LICENSE AND OTHER APPLICANTS TO THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that it is in the public interest to have positive identification of persons making certain types of application to the City of Kirkland, and

WHEREAS, the most positive and efficient method of identification presently known is that of fingerprinting,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Every person making application to the City of Kirkland in regard to the following shall, in addition to all other information and requirements which may be required by the ordinances of the City of Kirkland, be fingerprinted for the purpose of positive identification:

- Civil Service positions (police and fire)
- Taxi license and taxi operator's permits
- Ambulance license and ambulance operator's permits
- Private detective license
- merchant patrolman's license
- Concealed weapons and pistol purchase permits
- Public dance hall license
- Cabaret license.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
