

ORDINANCE NO. 2092

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO PUBLIC SAFETY, CRIMES, AND POLICE OFFICER'S POWER OF ARREST.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Any police officer of the City of Kirkland having information to support a reasonable belief that a person has committed or is committing a misdemeanor involving physical harm or threats of harm to any person or property, or the unlawful taking of property, or involving the use or possession of cannabis shall have the authority to arrest said person.

Section 2. The authority and power to arrest specified in Section 1 of this ordinance shall be in addition to all other powers of arrest as may exist under the laws and the statutes of the State of Washington and the ordinances of the City of Kirkland, provided that nothing in this ordinance shall extend or otherwise affect the powers of arrest relating to the use of motor vehicles and Ordinance No. 956 as now or hereafter amended.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
