

ORDINANCE NO. 2097

AN ORDINANCE OF THE KIRKLAND CITY COUNCIL FINDING THE EXISTENCE OF FUNDS RECEIVED IN EXCESS OF ANTICIPATED REVENUES DURING THE YEAR 1969, AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF SAME.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. From the report of the Director of Administration and Finance, the City Council for the City of Kirkland finds that the following sums so identified have been received during 1969 and are in excess of anticipated revenues. The City Council further authorizes the expenditure of such excess revenues during the 1969 budgetary year in the manner hereinafter set forth:

A. Equipment Rental:

(1) Excess revenue-equipment rental	\$10,090.00
(2) Expenditure authorized--	
maintenance and operation	\$6,090.00
capital outlay	<u>4,000.00</u>
TOTAL	\$10,090.00

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage and publication as required by law, provided, nevertheless, that the authorizations herein approved shall be deemed to have been effective as of December 31, 1969, and any actions heretofore taken by the Director of Administration and Finance in regard thereto are hereby ratified.
