AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO THE KIRKLAND WATER-SEWER SYSTEMS, ADJUSTING CERTAIN RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE, AND AMENDING SUBSECTION 6.06.020 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2062.

WHEREAS, it appears to the City Council of the City of Kirkland that the pro-rata cost of providing water and sewer service, including construction and maintenance of trunk and main systems to a multi-unit apartment structure, is less than the cost of providing such service to an equivalent number of single family residences, and

WHEREAS, such differential should be reflected in the water-sewer rate structure, and

WHEREAS, a review and study of the Kirkland water rate schedule and similar schedules prevailing in adjacent cities and utility districts indicate that some adjustment is appropriate in the Kirkland monthly sewer rate as it pertains to multi-unit apartments, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 6.06.020 of Ordinance No. 2062, adopted by the Kirkland City Council on the 21st day of July, 1969, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"6.06.020 Multi-family residence including duplex: \$.60 per 100 cubic feet of water consumed, provided, however, that the rate per apartment or unit shall be not less than \$4.50 for the first five units in any multi-family residence, nor less than \$4.00 for each unit in such multi-family residence in excess of five units or apartments."

Section 2. The rate adjustment herein provided shall become effective as to each customer as of the 1st day of February, 1970.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
