

ORDINANCE NO. 2100

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, VACATING THAT CERTAIN PORTION OF N.E. 57TH STREET LYING WITHIN THE PLAT OF BRIDLEWOOD CIRCLE AS SAID PLAT WAS RECORDED IN VOLUME 54 OF PLATS, PAGES 6 AND 7 RECORDS OF KING COUNTY.

WHEREAS, by Resolution heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, a date was set for a public hearing upon the proposed vacation of that certain street as more fully hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of said hearing was had in accordance with law, and

WHEREAS, following said public hearing held February 2, 1970, a vote of the Council was taken favoring said vacation, and

WHEREAS, it appears desirable and to the best interests of the City, its residents and the property owners abutting thereon that said street be vacated,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do Ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described portion of that certain Street known as N.E. 57th Street situate in King County, Washington and described as follows:

All of that portion of N.E. 57th Street lying within the Plat of Bridlewood Circle as said plat was recorded on November 12, 1954 in Volume 54 of Plats, Pages 6 and 7, records of King County, Washington,

be, and the same hereby is vacated, except that the City shall retain and reserve an easement, together with the right to exercise and grant easements along, over and across said vacated street for the installation, construction, repair and maintenance of public utilities and services.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
