

ORDINANCE NO. 2103

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, REZONING CERTAIN PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, AS DESCRIBED IN PLANNING COMMISSION FILE NO. R-2/70-3 FROM R-3 (MULTI-FAMILY) TO R-S (SEMI-PUBLIC).

WHEREAS, petition was filed for the reclassification of certain property hereinafter specifically described in the Planning Commission File No. R-2/70-3 and subsequently a hearing was held by the Kirkland Planning Commission March 12, 1970, and after hearing recommendation was made to the Kirkland City Council recommending such reclassification.

WHEREAS, pursuant to proper notice public hearing was then held by the City Council of the City of Kirkland on the 6th day of April, 1970.

NOW THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:


Section 1. The following specifically described property by and the same hereby is rezoned from R-3 (Multi-Family) to R-S (Semi-Public) classification.

Lots 11, 12, 13, & 14; Block 177; Town of Kirkland Addition as recorded in Records of King County.

Approximate Location: 8th Avenue at Market.

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect (5) days from and after its passage by the Council, and publication as required by law.

Passed by the City Council at a regular meeting on the 6th day of April, 1970.




