ORDINANCE NO. 2104

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON RELATING TO THE APPLICATION FOR BUILDING PERMIT AS TO PRIVATELY OWNED SUBMERGED SHORELANDS AND AMENDING SECTION 301(b) OF THE UNIFORM BUILDING CODE, VOLUME ONE, AS ADOPTED BY KIRKLAND ORDINANCE NO. 1140 TO BE THE BUILDING CODE FOR THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 301(b) of Volume One, of the Uniform Building Code, 1967 Edition as adopted for the City of Kirkland by Ordinance No. 1140 is hereby amended and supplemented by the addition thereto of a new subsection to be known as Section 301(b)8 to read as follows:

Section 301(b)8. No application for building permit relating to any construction (including land fill or piling and pier to support same) upon privately owned shorelands submerged by the Waters of Lake Washington shall be accepted for filing with the Building Department unless there is attached to such application, certified copies of the approval of such project by the United States Army Corps of Engineers, the Washington State Department of Fisheries and Game and such other State and Federal Agencies as may have jurisdiction or regulatory authority over such proposed project.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage and publication as required by law.
