ORDINANCE NO. 2124

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON RELATING TO THE KIRKLAND WATER-SEWER SYSTEM, ADJUSTING CERTAIN RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE AND AMENDING SUB-SECTION 6.06.020 OF ORDINANCE NO. 2062 AS HERETOFORE AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 2098.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, as follows:

Section 1. Section 6.06.020 of Ordinance No. 2062 adopted by the Kirkland City Council on the 21st day of July, 1969, and thereafter amended by Ordinance No. 2098, adopted February 16, 1970, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"6.06.020 MULTI-FAMILY RESIDENCE INCLUDE DUPLEX:
Fifty Cents per month, per unit or apartment plus sixty cents per 100 cubic feet of water consumed, provided however, that from and after January 1, 1971, the portion of the rate based upon water consumption shall be at the rate of seventy cents per 100 cubic feet of water consumed."

Section 2. The rate adjustment herein provided shall become effective as to each customer as of the 1st day of October, 1970.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
