## ORDINANCE NO. 2134

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE YEAR 1971.

WHEREAS, public hearing to consider the proposed budget for Kirkland for the year 1971 was duly and properly held on December 1, 1970 all in accordance with law, and
