ORDINANCE NO. 2147

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO FIREWORKS, THEIR POSSESSION AND SALE, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2125.

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2125 heretofore adopted by the Kirkland City Council on October 19, 1970, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to engage in the retail sale of or sell any fireworks within the City of Kirkland without first having obtained a license pursuant to the provisions of this ordinance.

Application for annual license shall be filed with the city on or before June 1 of each year.

Each application shall be accompanied with:

- (a) A map or plot plan showing dimensions of the fireworks stand, its location, and compliance with the requirements of this ordinance with specific reference to Section 10 as to temporary stands.
- (b) The annual license fee (Section 2)
- (c) Proof of insurance (Section 8-c)
- (d) Bond for removal (Section 8-e)
- (e) State of Washington fireworks license (Section 8-a)

Annual licenses will be issued to qualified applicants not later than June 7 of each year.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 2125 is in all other respects hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage and publication

as required by law.

Section 6. With the exception of those department heads, subject to the provisions of any applicable law, rule or regulation relating to civil service, the person, officer or employee designated by the City Manager to be accountable or responsible to him for the departmental function and operation shall be designated the director thereof.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
