

ORDINANCE NO. 2150

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, VACATING THAT CERTAIN PORTION OF 14th AVENUE LYING BETWEEN LOTS F & G OF SUPPLEMENTARY PLAT OF CENTRAL ADDITION TO KIRKLAND, AND AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2146 VACATING CERTAIN PORTIONS OF STREETS AND ALLEYS LYING WITHIN THE REPLACEMENT SITE FOR CENTRAL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL OF THE LAKE WASHINGTON SCHOOL DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, by resolutions heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, dates were set for public hearings upon the proposed vacation of those certain streets and alleys as more fully hereinafter described, and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of said hearings was had in accordance with law, and

WHEREAS, following said public hearings held March 15, 1971, and April 19, 1971, votes of the City Council were taken favoring said street and alley vacations, and

WHEREAS, it appears desirable and to the best interests of the City, its residents and property owners abutting thereon that the said streets and alleys be vacated,

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described portions of streets located within the area designated by the Lake Washington School District as its replacement site for Central Elementary School, and more particularly described as follows:

"That portion of 14th Avenue North bounded on the north by Lot F, and bounded on the south by Lot G, all in supplementary plat of Central Addition to Kirkland, according to plat thereof, records of King County."

be and the same hereby is vacated.

Section 2. Section 1 of Ordinance No. 2146 adopted by the Kirkland City Council on the 15th day of March, 1971, be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"Section 1. The following specifically described portions of streets and alleys located within the area designated by the Lake Washington School District as its replacement site for Central Elementary School, and more particularly described as follows:

- (a) That portion of 13th Avenue (Jefferson Avenue) lying between the Burlington Northern Railway right-of-way on the east, and the westerly lot line of lot 30, block 20, Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland, according to plat thereof, records of King County, as said lot line is extended south to the northwest corner of lot 21, block 21, Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland.
- (b) That portion of east - west alley in block 20, Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland, lying between the westerly common lot line of lot 30 and lot 21 in said block 20, and the centerline of the north - south alley lying between said block 20 and block 19, all in Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland.
- (c) All of that portion of the north - south alley lying between Block 19 and Block 20 in Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland which abuts Lots 6 through 10, inclusive, in said Block 19.
- (d) That portion of north - south alley lying between Blocks 21 and 22, and Lake Avenue Addition to Kirkland which abuts Lot 1, Block 21,

be and the same hereby are each vacated."

Section 3. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
