ORDINANCE NO. 2164

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE REQUIREMENTS FOR A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION BEFORE A BINGO GAME, RAFFLE OR AMUSEMENT GAME MAY BE CONDUCTED WITHIN THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. <u>Definitions</u>. The terms "bingo", "raffle", "amusement game", and "charitable or non-profit organization" shall have the same meaning as set forth in Section of Chapter 280, Laws of 1971, First Extraordinary Session, as now or hereafter amended.

Section 2. <u>Registration Required</u>. No charitable or non profit organization shall conduct a bingo game, a raffle, or an amusement game within the City of Kirkland unless a certificate of registration shall have been issued as hereinafter provided and such organization has its principal office or meeting place within the City of Kirkland.

Section 3. <u>Procedure for Registration</u>. Applications for registration shall be filed with the office of the City Manager and shall include:

(1) The date or dates when, and the location where the bingo game, raffle or amusement game will be conducted.

(2) The name of the owner of the location where the bingo game, raffle or amusement game will be conducted, and the name of the person who will manage the bingo game, raffle or amusement game.

(3) A copy of the Articles of Incorporation of the Charitable or non-profit organization conducting the bingo game, raffle or amusement game.

(4) A copy of the statement of the Internal Revenue Service, if any, stating that contributions to the organization qualify for charitable contribution deduction purposes, or that the organization is otherwise exempt from payment of federal income taxes pursuant to the Internal Revenue Act of 1954, as amended; and

(5) Each application for registration shall be accompanied by a registration fee of \$25.00.

Section 4. Upon receipt of an application for registration as set forth in Section 3, the office of the City Manager shall issue a certificate of registration. Section 5. It shall be unlawful for any person to refuse or to hinder or delay the inspection and audit of any charitable or non-profit organization as provided for in Section 8 of Chapter 280, Laws of 1971, First Extraordinary Session.

Section 6. <u>Violation Misdemeanor</u>. Any violation of this ordinance or of any provisions of Chapter 280, Laws of 1971; nEirst Extraordinary Session, shall constitute a misdemeanor and the punishment shall be as provided by the ordinances of the City of Kirkland or by the laws of the State of Washington as applicable.

Section 7. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
