

ORDINANCE NO. 2176

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND INCREASING AND ESTABLISHING THE SALARY TO BE RECEIVED BY ELECTED CITY OFFICIALS, AND AMENDING SECTIONS 3.08.010 and 3.08.020 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: Section 3.08.010 be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

3.08.010. Salaries-Elected Officials (Councilman and Mayor) The salaries for elected officials are hereby established to be as follows:

Councilman: \$ 100.00 per month

The councilman serving as mayor shall, while so serving, receive an additional: \$ 100.00 per month.

The individuals holding the offices for which salaries are herein established shall be entitled to receive such salaries commencing with the month of January, 1974. Until said date said elected officials shall continue to receive the salaries established by Ordinance No. 2082.

Section 2: Section 3.08.020 of the Kirkland Municipal Code is hereby amended to read as follows:

3.08.020. Salaries-Other Officers and Employees. For all other city offices and positions as may from time to time be established (including but not by way of limitation, the City Manager and the Director of Administration and Finance-ex officio City Clerk/Treasurer), the salaries shall be as set forth in the annual budget as adopted for each year.

Section 3: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
