

ORDINANCE NO. 2181

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND, WASHINGTON, VACATING THAT CERTAIN PORTION OF N.E. 97th STREET, LYING BETWEEN 117th AVENUE N.E. AND THE WESTERLY RIGHT-OF-WAY LINE OF INTERSTATE HIGHWAY NO. 405 ALL SITUATE WITHIN BURKE & FARRAR'S KIRKLAND ADDITION TO THE CITY OF SEATTLE, DIVISION NO. 14 AND THE CITY OF KIRKLAND.

WHEREAS, by Resolution heretofore adopted by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, a date was set for Public Hearing upon the proposed vacation of that certain street hereinafter specifically described, and

WHEREAS, due and proper notice of said Hearing was had in accordance with law, and

WHEREAS, following said Public Hearing held March 20th, 1972 a vote of the Council was taken favoring said street vacation, and

WHEREAS, it appears desirable and to the best interests of the City, its residents, and property owners abutting thereon that said Street be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, the City Council of the City of Kirkland do ordain as follows:

Section 1. The following specifically described portion of street located within Burke & Farrar's Kirkland Addition to the City of Seattle, Division No. 14, and more particularly described as follows:

"That certain portion of N.E. 97th Street lying between the Easterly right-of-way line of 117th Avenue N.E., and the Westerly right-of-way line of Interstate 405, all within Kirkland, King County, Washington, be and the same hereby is vacated.
