

ORDINANCE NO. 2203

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE REGISTRATION OF FELONS AND REPEALING CHAPTER 11.56 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE IN TOTO.

WHEREAS, the registration of felon requirements established in Chapter 11.56 of the Kirkland Municipal Code are in direct conflict with Section 10 of Chapter 152, Laws of 1972 of the Washington State Legislature,

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 11.56 entitled "Registration of Felons", including Sections 11.56.010 through 11.56.080, inclusive, be and they hereby are repealed in toto.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
