

ORDINANCE NO. 2212

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND REGULATING CELEBRATIONS,
PROVIDING FOR A CELEBRATION LICENSE AND STANDARDS FOR CONDUCT,
AND DEFINING CELEBRATION.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Definition of Celebration.

"Celebration" shall mean activity or combination of activities subject to the licensing provisions of Chapters 7.20 or 7.24 of the Kirkland Municipal Code; provided that such activities are carried on or conducted on not more than 10 days in any six month period as measured by the date of issuance of the license hereinafter provided for.

Section 2. Celebration license required.

It shall be unlawful to conduct, manage, operate or sponsor a celebration as herein defined without first obtaining from the City of Kirkland a valid and subsisting celebration license.

Section 3. Celebration license, rules governing - fees.

Celebration licenses, their issuance and revocation, shall be governed by Sections 7.20.030, 7.20.040 and 7.20.080 of Title 7 of the Kirkland Municipal Code. The license fee for a celebration license shall be \$25.00 per day for each such day that the celebration activities shall actually be conducted, within the time limits set forth in Section 1.

Section 4. Standards of conduct.

The actual conduct of the celebration activities shall be subject to the standards of conduct set forth in Chapter 7.20 and 7.24.

Section 5. Limitation on issuance of celebration licenses.

A celebration license shall not issue to any person holding a valid cabaret dance license or celebration license.

Section 6. This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publication as required by law.
