ORDINANCE NO. 2215

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN PURSUANT TO RCW CHAPTER 39.34 A CONTRACT WITH KING COUNTY FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SEA-KING ALERT SYSTEM A REGIONAL CRIMINAL JUSTICE INFORMATION ELECTRONIC DATA SYSTEM.

WHEREAS, King County, through its office of System Services intends to maintain a regional criminal justice information system making use of electronic data processing equipment on a time sharing basis, to provide for the storage, manipulation and retrival of information made available to common files by law enforcement agencies including that of the City of Kirkland and other cities, towns or other municipal corporations who are vested by the laws of the State of Washington with the administration and/or enforcement of law and criminal justice, and

WHEREAS, said system to be known as the Sea-King Alert System will be administered and supervised by an Executive Council made up of representatives of the participating municipal corporations, and

WHEREAS, the cost of such service will be reimbursed on an agreed basis to King County, and

WHEREAS, a contract for participation by the City of Kirkland in such an agreement has been presented to the City and recommended by the Kirkland Police Department, now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. The Mayor of Kirkland be and he hereby is authorized to sign for the City of Kirkland that certain agreement for participation in the Sea-King Alert System, a copy of which is attached to the original of this Ordinance and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council

and publication as required by law.
