

ORDINANCE NO. 2243

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND EXTENDING THE EXISTENCE OF THE HOUGHTON MUNICIPAL COMMUNITY FOR AN ADDITIONAL FOUR YEAR TERM.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. There is hereby added to Chapter 2.16 of the Kirkland Municipal Code a new section to read as follows:

"Section 2.16.020 - Term Extended. Pursuant to the approval of the voters within the Houghton Municipal Community, as expressed at a General Municipal Election held November 6, 1973, the existence of the Houghton Municipal Community shall be extended for an additional four year term to end on the 1st Monday in January, 1978."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication as required by law.
