## ORDINANCE NO. 2259

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO CRIMES BY OR AGAINST PUBLIC OFFICERS AND AMENDING SECTION 11.08.020 KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 11.08.020 of the Kirkland Municipal Code be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"11.08.020 OBSTRUCTING PUBLIC OFFICERS.

Every person who, after due notice, refuses or neglects to inform a public officer as to his legal name, permanent address or current place of residence, (make-ep-furnish-any-statement,-report ep-information-lawfully-required-by-him by-any-public-efficer) or who in such statement, report or information makes any willfully untrue or misleading (ep exaggerated) statement or who willfully hinders, delays or obstructs any public officer in the discharge of his official powers or duties is guilty of a misdemeanor."

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Kirkland City Council and publication as required by law.
