ORDINANCE NO. 2268

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE DISPLAY OF LIGHTED LAMPS AND ILLUMINATING DEVICES ON MOTOR VEHICLES AND AMENDING SUB-SECTION 46.37.020 OF SECTION 12.60.010 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

WHEREAS, Section 12.60.010 of the Kirkland Municipal Code adopts by reference certain sections of Title 46 Revised Code of Washington relating to the operation of motor vehicles and,

WHEREAS, the 43rd Session of the Washington State Legislature 3rd Extraordinary Session did by Section 2, Chapter 124 amend RCW 46.37.020 by adding the following language thereto: "Provided that every motorcycle and every motor driven cycle shall have its head and tail lamps lighted whenever such vehicle is in motion on a highway." and,

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of uniformity and traffic safety that the City of Kirkland amend the appropriate sub-section of its traffic code to also require the display of lighted head and tail lamps on motorcycles and motor driven cycles while in operation.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section 1: Section RCW 46.37.020 Revised Code of Washington (heretofore adopted by reference as sub-section 46.37.020 of Section 12.60.010 Kirkland Municipal Code) is hereby re-adopted by reference in order to conform to said section as amended by Section 2, Chapter 124, 1974 Session Laws.

IS HEREBY readopted by reference in order to conform to said section 2, Chapter 124, 1974 Session Laws.

Section 2: This ordinance shall be in force and take effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication
