ORDINANCE NO. 2290

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO THE OPENING OR CONSUMING OF INTOXICATING LIQUOR IN PUBLIC PLACES AND AMENDING SUBSECTION 11.32.050(1) OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland, as follows:

Section 1. Subsection 11.32.050(1) of the Kirkland Municipal Code is amended to read as follows:

"Except in such public places as are specifically identified and posted as places where intoxicating liquor may be consumed, no person shall open the package containing intoxicating liquor or consume intoxicating liquor in a public place or way open to the public."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the council and publication as required by law.
