

ORDINANCE NO. 2295

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND ESTABLISHING THE DATE FOR PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE PROPOSED CITY BUDGET FOR THE ENSUING YEAR AND AMENDING SECTION 3.10.050 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 3.10.050 of the Kirkland Municipal Code be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

"3.10.050 Budget - Hearing. Annually on or before the first [~~business-day-of~~] Monday in December, the Council shall meet in public hearing to consider the proposed budget for the ensuing year. Said hearing may be continued from day to day, but in no event beyond the 6th day of December. The Council in said meeting at the conclusion of the hearing, may make such adjustments and changes as it deems necessary or proper and then adopt the budget or may defer taking action on the budget until either of the regular December business meetings."

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect five days from and after its passage by the Council and publication as required by law.
