ORDINANCE NO. 2334

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF KIRKLAND RELATING TO ANIMAL CONTROL AND LICENSING PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL PERMANENT DOG OR CAT LICENSE FOR CITY RESIDENTS SIXTY-FIVE YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER, AND AMENDING CHAPTER 8.02 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNCIPAL CODE BY ADDING A NEW SECTION THERETO TO BE KNOWN AS SECTION 8.02.015.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1: There is hereby added to Chapter 8.02 of the Kirkland Municipal Code a new section to be designated as Section 8.02.015 to read as follows:

Special Permanent bicance for The Public B

"Section 8.02.015. <u>Senior Eitizens Special Permanent B</u>o or Cat License. Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Chapter relating to dog or cat licenses and the fees established therefor, City of Kirkland residents sixty-five years of age or older shall be entitled to purchase a special permanent license for the lifetime of cats or dogs for which they are the registered owners when said animals are maintained at said owner's registered address. Eligible residents may purchase the special permanent animal license at a cost of \$8.00 per licensed dog and \$4.00 per licensed cat, and they shall not be required to annually purchase a new license for the lifetime of such licensed animals provided that no person shall be granted more than three (3) permanent animal licenses for any combination of three (3) cats and dogs for which they are the registered owner, and providing further that the Animal Control authority is authorized to enact the necessary rules and procedures to efficiently implement the program. The effective date for such licenses shall be April 1, 1977."

Section 2: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the City Council and publication as required by law.
