ORDINANCE NO. 2341

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO WATERS AND SURFACE CRAFT PROHIBITING THE USE OF VESSELS AND WATERCRAFT FOR HABITATION AND AMENDING CHAPTER 14.44 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

<u>Section 1</u>. Chapter 14.44 of the Kirkland Municipal Code relating to miscellaneous rules and regulations for waters and surface craft within the City of Kirkland is hereby amended and supplemented with the addition of a new section to read as follows:

> "14.44.040 Vessels and watercraft not to be used for habitation. No boat, vessel, watercraft or houseboat moored in or off the shoreline of Kirkland shall be used as a place of habitation. The use of bilge pumps or toilets when such craft is meered or within the waters of Lake Washington adjacent to the City of Kirkland is prohibited."

<u>Section 2</u>. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the City Council and publication as required by law.
