ORDINANCE NO. 2344

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO DOOR-TO-DOOR SOLICITATION FOR SALE OF GOODS BY CHARITABLE, RELIGIOUS OR NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS, AND AMENDING SECTION 11.48.050 OF THE KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE RELATING TO PERSONS EXEMPT FROM THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 11.48.030 KIRKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE, COMMONLY REFERRED TO AS THE "GREEN RIVER ORDINANCE."

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Kirkland as follows:

Section 1. Section 11.48.050 of the Kirkland Municipal Code be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

11.48.050 Certain persons exempt. The provisions of Sections 11.48.030 and 11.48.040 of this Chapter shall not apply to any farmer, gardener or other person while selling, delivering, peddling any fruits, vegetables, berries, butter, eggs, fish, milk, poultry, meats or any other farm produce or edibles raised, caught, produced or manufactured by such person in any place in the State of Washington.

The provisions of Section 11.48.030 and 11.48.040 of this Chapter shall not apply to any person or organization or association when engaged in a charitable solicitation provided that such person, organization, or association is not in violation of either Chapter 7.56 Kirkland Municipal Code or Chapter 19.09 Revised Code of Washington (relating to regulation of charitable solicitation activities).

Section 2. This ordinance shall be in force and effect five (5) days from and after its passage by the City Council of the City of Kirkland and publication as required by law.


